3. providing visitors with Shabbos meals, if needed
4. those in our community who could use a break from a long week, need some care and support due to life-cycle events, want to socialize, etc.

To achieve this goal however, we need help from our members. We are looking for at least 10 Shaarey Zedek families who are Shomer Shabbos/ Shomer Kashrus*, who are willing to host. The privilege and work involved in these great mitzvos will be shared among all the hosts. The process is simple: Via email and a Google doc, one can choose to host for a specific date/meal. No one will be expected to host when they are simply too busy.
